Road Closures (Please see separate email for more details)



How we plan to carry out the works The works are being carried out in phases under a road closure as follows

- Phase 1 The closure of Dover Road between the A258 Castle Hill Road and Burgoyne Heights to
- Phase 1 The closure of Dover Road between the A258 Castle Hill Road and Burgoyne Heights to enable Affinity Water to carry out the new water main connection close to Fort Burgoyne. Access to all properties within the closure will be maintained from the A258 Castle Hill Road, with pedestrian and cycle access maintained from the Costre. Access to Guston Primary School and Burgoyne Heights will be maintained from the Guston side. This closure will be in place from 12 February for a maximum period of 1 week.
 Phase 2 This will involve the closure of Dover Road between Old Charlton Road and Burgoyne Heights, will allow Affinity Water to complete the disconnection of the water main and for KCC to undertake the widening and resurfacing of the carriageway. During the working day it will not be possible to maintain actors through the works for pedestrians or cyclists due to safety requirements, but a pedestrian and cycle route will be provided through the closure outside of working hours. Access to Guston Primary School and Burgoyne Heights will be maintained from 12 February for approximately 7 weeks.
 Phase 3 This will require the repeat of the Phase 1 closure to enable the road resurfacing to be completed between Burgoyne Heights and Fort Burgoyne. Howerk, we are currently exploring the possibility of carrying out this work as part of the Phase 1 road closure, which could reduce the overall duration of the work.

A signed diversion route will be provided via Dover Road, The Lane, A258 Deal Road, and A258 Castle Hill Road.
