School Drop off

We have been noticing recently that some children are being left unsupervised at the school gates or nearby streets in the morning. Some children are also being left in the school playground very early. This is a **safeguarding** issue.

I am writing to clarify that all pupils in YR-Y5 must be accompanied to one of the school doors by a responsible adult where they can be handed over to the member of staff on duty. These doors open at <u>8.35am</u>.

The playground is not supervised by a member of staff so it is expected all children should be supervised by an adult before going into the school building.

The reasons we open the doors early and have a staggered start to the day is three fold:

- To avoid the potential chaos of lots of children and adults being on the playground at one time.
- It gives both parents and teachers the opportunity to catch each other in the mornings if necessary.
- It gives pupils a calm start to the day where they have the opportunity to talk to their teachers on a more individual basis before the register is taken.
